The Chauncey B. Warner Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in June 1986 by the Board of Managers of the Warner Home for Little Wanderers, Inc. as a memorial to his many years of dedicated service to needy children of Franklin County.

Up to 10 Franklin County high schools graduating seniors will be presented with the Chauncey B. Warner Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship is open to students who have been accepted to a post-secondary undergraduate program such as an associate degree, bachelor's degree, technology program, or other advanced training. Please note the scholarship is **based on financial need and initiative**.

The Board of Managers will award up to 10, \$3,000 or less, scholarships amongst the five Franklin County high schools.

Payment will be made directly to the student's choice of school from the Chauncey B. Warner Scholarship Fund upon satisfactory proof of enrollment.

1. **Return- One complete copy** of your parent(s)/guardian(s) previous years U.S. Income Tax Return listing you as a dependent by **May 1**.
2. **Return- Four copies, first page only**, of the previous years U.S. Income Tax Return showing adjusted income by **May 1**.
3. **Return- Five copies** of each application form, **including your 200-word essay, by May 1**.
4. **Return- Five copies** of your transcript by **May 1**.
